

Chairman Nelson Brenneman called the Recessed meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. with the following in attendance:

The Board of Supervisors continued with reviewing and discussion on the Budget.

Sharon began the presentation with the General Funds Expenditures, where the last budget discussion ended.

Discussion on the Stoverstown Baseball field- do we wish to continue paying for the maintenance and supplies for this field, if it only benefits a small percent of the township residents. Yes.

Discussion regarding concerns with rust areas around the outside of the Township building. Mr. Luckenbaugh will try to get a quote to replace the panels near the bottom of the siding so that it can be included in the budget. Mr. Luckenbaugh is also seeking a quote to replace the spouting on the NCT Fire Co. building.

Road Master Rodney Shearer, discussed what roads he is proposing to do in 2019, but does not have the total costs, at this time. He is waiting for our Engineer Vincent Wayne to get back to him. He does however, suggest we increase the Engineer fees, for the purpose of DEP permit requirements. Mr. Shearer will present more information regarding the cost for the proposed road projects, at the next regular BOS meeting, November 20, 2018.

### **General Public Comment**

Joseph Smith, 1303 Sunnyside Rd., claims Martin Road-Dirt & Gravel, black top and stones have washed out into the field. Mr. Smith feels there were mistakes made, and would like for Mr. Shearer to take a look at the conditions. Both Rodney and Nelson will check it out.

John Rebert, 1470 Sunnyside Rd., inquiring on when the next Budget meeting will be held and asked if there is a separate budget for the roads.

Jackie Hall, 1477 Linton Terrace, asked why the NCT Sewer, reimburses the Township for expenses. We charge back to the Sewer, a percentage of the township administration costs for processing the billing and any labor provided by our Public works department.

Bill Welsby, 1473 Sunnyside Rd., expressed his concerns with the speeding on Sunnyside, it being the cause of a recent accident. He would like to see more speed control for this road, some type of radar speed limit sign, to slow drivers down. It was noted that 90% are given warnings, not actual violations.

Discussion was held with regards to SWRPD, and resident Willa Lefever, 4796 Lehman Rd., thanked the Board members for giving their perspective on some of the issues. She hopes to build communications between NCT & SWRPD.

Mr. Luckenbaugh thanked those attending for coming, and Mr. Shearer noted that they will try to answer as many questions as possible, in the upcoming meetings.
